HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices – Reminder of Availability

St. John Fisher University provides benefits through group health plans (including the health care flexible spending account) (collectively, the Plan) to its eligible employees and their eligible dependents. By so doing, the Plan creates, receives, uses and maintains health information about Plan participants which is protected by federal law (protected health information, or PHI). The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, as amended (HIPAA) requires health plans to provide Plan participants and others with a notice of the Plan's privacy practices with regard to the health information it creates and maintains in the course of providing benefits (Notice of Privacy Practices). This Notice of Privacy Practices describes the way the Plan uses and discloses PHI.
